### U.S. CONSTITUTION REQUIREMENT

Before a credential is granted, all teacher candidates must satisfy the Commission Teacher Credentialing (CTC) Constitution requirement. You can do this in one of the four ways listed below:

1. If you earned your undergraduate degree from a CSU campus, you have already met this requirement
2. Show evidence on your official transcript of having taken a course in U.S. government, history, or politics. An AP U.S. government or history course counts if it appears on your college transcript showing 2 or more credit units. Check with the Credential & Graduate Services Center ([credinfo@sfsu.edu](mailto:credinfo@sfsu.edu)) to find out whether a course you have taken will count. A course description and/or course syllabus may be required.
3. Complete a course (two semester units or three-quarter units) in the provisions and principles of the United States Constitution.
4. Pass an examination in the subject given by a regionally accredited community college, college, or university. Listed below are some test administration sites.
